

Off Licence

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Southern Style Adventures Limited** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **2 McFeely Street, Tuatapere**, and known as “**Tui Base Camp**”, to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No liquor shall be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on ANZAC Day
- (b) Liquor may be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - **Monday to Sunday 7am to 11pm**
- (c) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) serving staff are trained to identify intoxication, and proactively dealing with potentially intoxicated persons.
 - (ii) appropriate signs detailing the provisions of the act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons must be displayed at every point of sale.
- (d) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers at the same location as alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.

Licensed Premises

The premises generally is more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped by the Southland District Council on 15 August 2019. The entrance from the car park is designated as the principal entrance.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) either –
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed until the close of the period of 12 months after that day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
 - (i) until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of four years after the day it was issued.
